Characteristics of Autism Spectrum Disorder

- They may be nonverbal or have a communication device
- They may not understand what you are saying
- They may say what they think you want to hear
- They may experience anxiety with your presence
- They may not respond to your presence
- They may also have other co-morbid medical conditions
- They may not understand your body language/facial expressions
- They may attracted to shiny and bright things
- They may be attracted to water; They are prone to wander
- They are unique individuals

Suggestions

- Display calming body language, give person extra personal space
- Give extra time for the person to reply
- Be aware there is a high risk for elopement with no fear of real danger
- Very likely person has high anxiety and will display adverse, possibly aggressive, behavior. Use distraction or calming techniques for people who are anxious or aggressive
- Keep noise to a minimum. Low lights and always ask before you touch the person
- Each individual with autism is unique and may act or react differently
- The person may repeat your words/phrases/body language. Try using pictures, fill- in the blank questions, or yes/no questions
