

# Visiting a Community Farmers Market

# Today, we are going to a Community Farmers Market





What will we see? Many tents, people, food, plants and crafts. What are crafts? Crafts may be clothes, jewelry, paintings, pictures, toys, ceramic items that might break if touched.



What will we hear? People talking and music. We will be ok. 



What will we smell? Food cooking but it will be pleasant.



What can we touch? Nothing on display in the tents *or* the tents, many items can break if touched – only things that our parent(s) or caregiver tells us are OK to touch.



How long will it take? Every visit is different. We may be there for an hour or \_\_\_\_ hours.

# There will be tents that have food and crafts.

- We may have to wait in line to look at food and crafts
- Each item at the market costs money
- We may buy food and crafts today. We may wait until the next time we visit to buy food and crafts



# We will stay together at the market

- It is important to stay with the person(s) you came with
- No leaving an area by yourself
- If you get lost, stay by a tent at the market
- Sometimes, the market is inside a building





# We will try not to touch the food and crafts

- We can touch the food and crafts after we have paid for them
- We can eat and play with the crafts when we get home
- Lets try to leave the food and crafts in our basket and enjoy the market!



# There may be pets, like dogs, that people bring to the market to visit

- It is ok to look at the pet
- Lets try not to touch the pet. They may not like being touched!



We can throw our trash in the trash cans

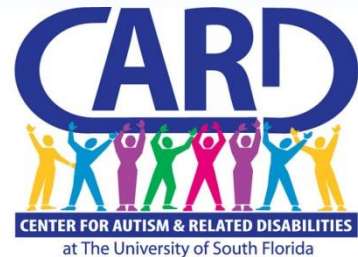


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
