Events, notices and books, just for us



As we enter the Teen Room, we will see a bulletin board with notices of events, programs and meetings that we might be interested in. Check it out!



Books mostly for teens and young adults are in this room. If I want to look at other books, there are also youth fiction, youth DVDs, and youth non-fiction books out in the main area of the 2nd floor. I can go to the 3rd floor to see non-fiction and magazines, or the 1st floor to see fiction, DVDs and CDs.

What can we do in the teen room?



We can look at books, we can use the computers, we can play games, we can have meeting, or we can hang out.


We can use the computers at the library to look up books and other things in the catalog. We do not need a library card to use the catalog.

If we want to use the computers for anything else, such as internet, we must have a library card or ask for a "Computer Use Only Card". With the computer use only card, we can use the computers for three months.

X-Box Rules

The X-Box game can only be played when a librarian is present.

We do NOT need a library card to play video games in the library's gaming events.



Restrooms



There is a restroom in the Youth Services department that we can use. This restroom has paper towels, not the loud hand dryers that are in the other restrooms at the library.




If we go to other restrooms in the library, we may want to be ready for the loud noise made by the hand dryers.

Checking out books, DVDs and CDs on the 2nd Floor



We can check out books and other things by ourselves! We will use this checkout station. If we need help, we will ask a librarian to help us learn how to use it.

Returning library books or other things









We can return books, DVDs and other things inside the library, or we can stay in the car and drive to the return station in the parking lot.

Café and bookstore





The café and bookstore hours are posted on signs on the windows. They might be open or closed when we visit the library.

We can look at the times they are open and come back another time if we want to visit the café or bookstore.

The bookstore has things for sale. We don't borrow things and return them from this part of the library. We can pay for them and keep them.
