This is the entrance of Huntington Learning Center. My parent might wait here during my lesson.



When I arrive, I will sign in on the tablet and get my white binder.





I will know which one is mine because it will have my name on the side.

This is the main area where I will do my work. I may have a tutor all to myself, or I may be part of a small group. There may be other students working with their tutors in this area, too.







This is a small room that I can use if I need a break, or to take a test.

I can also ask to use this room for my work time if it is empty and I am having trouble focusing.



If I want, I can bring snacks or drinks to Huntington and keep them in the fridge.

There are restrooms in the back of the building.



I will try my best to do
my work and follow my
tutor's instructions, but if
I need a break,
Huntington has crayons
and whiteboards if I want
to draw. I can also bring
my headphones or fidget
items from home if I
need them.



When it is time to go home I will put my binder away and pack up the things I brought with me.
