

Age of Majority Fact Sheet: Finding the Right Attorney

Network with other families who have gone through the process and ask them about their experience and for recommendations.

Ask a professional you know and trust for recommendations.

Speak to advocacy organizations such as: <u>The Arc of Florida</u>, <u>Family</u> <u>Network on Disabilities</u>, and <u>Disability Rights Florida</u>

Check the internet or telephone directory for attorneys that specialize in Guardianship.
