

# Medication Safety Tips

## AUTISM & POISON PREVENTION

Call 911 if  
someone is  
unresponsive!

- Take medications as prescribed
- Never call medications candy
- Do not share medications
- Keep medications out of reach and out of sight
- Use cabinet locks and child resistant lids
- Use a medication lock box or lock bag
- Adult supervision is always important
- Dispose of unused or expired medications

**If someone stops breathing,  
collapses or has a seizure, call 911.**

confidential help 24/7.
