Medication Safety Tips AUTISM & POISON PREVENTION

- **Take medications as prescribed**
- Never call medications candy
- Do not share medications
- Keep medications out of reach and out of sight
- Use cabinet locks and child resistant lids
- Use a medication lock box or lock bag
- Adult supervision is always important
- Dispose of unused or expired medications

If someone stops breathing, collapses or has a seizure, call 911.
