At a seder, we eat special foods.



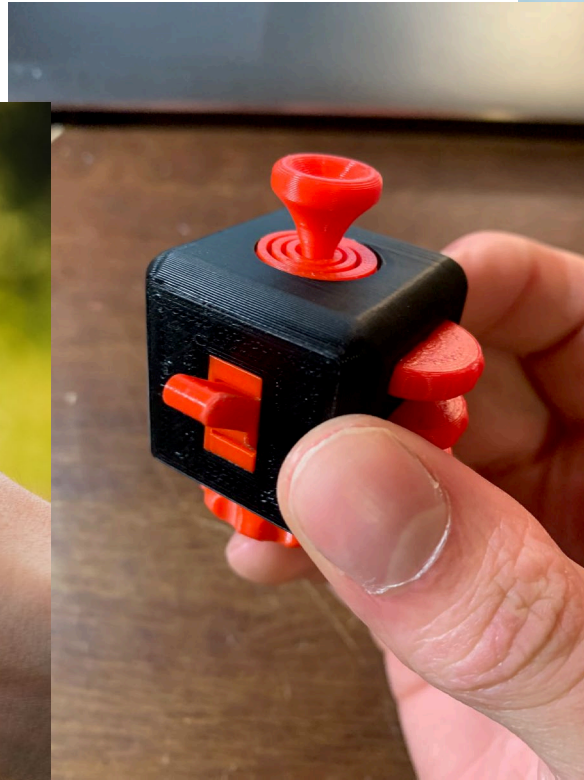
